SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

Recipients will be reviewed and granted available funds on a first-come, first-serve basis until all available funds are used. We review financial needs, letters of recommendation that speak of character, persistence, and the proclivity to take and follow-through on instruction. We will also examine the student's willingness and ability to contribute to a positive, inclusive, and supportive school culture.

Eligible attendees must be 18 years of age or older with demonstrated financial need and a commitment to completing the RAAC curriculum.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Applicants must be Colorado residents to be considered. Financial assistance and scholarship funding are based on financial need. Please attach to this form:

Proof of income (income taxes or one month most recent pay stubs)

RAAC can only review complete applications. Incomplete applications will not be accepted. RAAC reserves the right to grant scholarships at its own discretion. No cash value is attached or will be awarded for scholarships. We do not offer refunds, transfers or credits for registered courses.

Students who qualify for full scholarship funding receive:

- Tuition for one quarter
- Tuition for up to 4 quarters (pending end-of-quarter review and acceptance)

Students who qualify for partial scholarship will receive:

- 50% off the registration fee for one quarter
- 50% off the registration fee for up to 4 quarters (pending end-of-quarter review and acceptance)

Once a student qualifies for scholarship funding, they still need to apply each and every quarter for further assistance. Winter, Spring, Summer and Fall quarters. Students can re-apply the following year and must do so for RAAC to award any full or partial scholarship grants.
